## Seeing and Savoring Jesus Christ Supplemental Reading Plan

The supplemental reading plan to *Seeing and Savoring Jesus Christ* is intended to encourage the union of meditation over the word of God and prayer for God's grace. Here are just a few suggestions and comments regarding how you may wish to use this resource:

- Each chapter of *Seeing and Savoring* has been broken down into three days. The chapter may be read on any or all of those days.
- Under each day there are a number of Scripture references. The references in **bold** lettering are the primary verses and passages to be read for that day. These typically number between 3-6 different sections in the Bible (with a few exceptions). The references that are not in bold lettering are meant to provide opportunities for further study and reflection.
- You can begin at any point. If you want to read straight through the book and follow the divisions of this plan that would be great. However, it can be equally beneficial to take selected chapters and use the verse references as springboards for further study on a particular topic (e.g. the sufferings of Jesus, chapter 8).
- Ask questions of each passage. What is the main point of the passage? How does
  this passage fit in the context? How does this passage relate to the other passages or
  verses read on that day? How does it relate to the theme of the corresponding
  chapter in Seeing and Savoring?
- Pray often and pray hard. Make the words you read in the Bible your prayers. If you
  read of Jesus healing a blind man, pray for God to heal your blindness that prevents
  you from seeing him. If you read of Jesus' remarkable compassion, pray for a
  transformed heart that joyfully and sacrificially loves others. And at all times pray that
  God would open your eyes to see the Jesus who is revealed in the Bible.

We hope and pray that this resource proves to be beneficial for you. And we pray that God will shine his light into your heart, "To give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ" (2 Cor. 4:6).
